## SANCTUARIES, PRESERVES AND CONSERVATION EASEMENTS — WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

A SWMLC sanctuary/preserve is owned by SWMLC and open to the public. You are encouraged to paint on these lands any time. Go to the SWMLC web site to see a complete list of these locations.

A SWMLC conservation easement is private property, closed to the public but managed by the Conservancy. PAAWM artists have been given special permission by the landowners to paint on their land for our scheduled paint outs.

If you would like to paint at a conservation easement other than during a scheduled paint out, please contact the SWMLC, they will contact the land owner and seek permission for you. Please be respectful of the land you have the privilege to paint on.
